An Overview of 2020 EAMCP Qingdao Forum

The 2020 East Asia Marine Cooperation Platform Qingdao Forum (hereinafter referred to as Qingdao Forum) is scheduled from September 21 to 27 at the International Convention Center of Qingdao Cosmopolitan Exposition, which will adopt the mode of "offline + online".

It is sponsored by the Ministry of Natural Resource of the People's Republic of China and the People's Government of Shandong Province, hosted by Qingdao Municipal People's Government and organized by the Administrative Committee of Qingdao West Coast New Area.

The Qingdao Forum this year, under General Secretary Xi Jinping's instructions to "invigorate the city through hosting important international events", and guided by the principle of "building blue partnerships, and creating a marine community with a shared future", is themed with "Open and integrated, To enjoy the future wisely". It applies a "Forum + exhibition" and "offline + online" mode, and centers on "port, trade, shipping and finance", consisting of seven major events, namely "the opening ceremony and main forum, four sub-forums, the final competition of Global Marine Talent Innovation and Entrepreneurship Competition and East Asia Marine Expo". The forum features an international platform powered by specialized achievements and works toward a hallmark event, and focuses on international cooperation in the fields of marine economy, science and technology, civilization, environmental protection and disaster prevention and mitigation.

The main forum is expected to welcome distinguished guests from all 10 ASEAN countries, Japan and the ROK, the largest participation scale ever, and it will meanwhile have guests from some other island countries. Incumbent vice-ministerial level officials from some ASEAN countries, and heads of international marine organizations such as IOC are invited for the first time. The forum will include an opening video, keynote speeches, publish annual report of East Asian Ocean Cooperative Research.

Sub-forums include International Healthy Ocean High-end Forum, East Asia Marine Culture and Tourism Development Forum, East Asian Ports Association Congress, International Forum on Algae and Health Industry.
